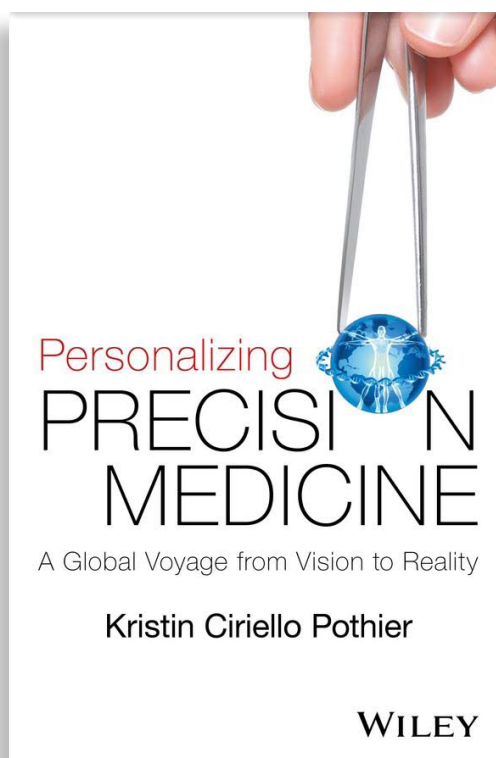
A Global Voyage from Vision to Reality
