ABSTRACT:

In its 33rd year of publication under the Thai Society of Critical Care Medicine and entering its 5th year as *Clinical Critical Care*, the journal has reached another milestone by being indexed in the Thai-Journal Citation Index (TCI) Tier 1. This editorial will highlight the published works of the journal, along with expert reviews from various fields, whose insights and critiques have contributed to refining and enhancing the quality of the published research.

PUBLICATIONS AND INDEXING

On February 4, 2025, the journal has been officially indexed in the Thai-Journal Citation Index (TCI) Tier 1 (Figure 1), with quality certification valid from January 1, 2025, to December 31, 2029. This is marking a significant milestone in the continuous improvement of Clinical Critical Care. This achievement is particularly meaningful as the journal enters its 33rd year of publication and its 5th year of advancing toward international standards and publishing in English.

The editorial team would like to extend sincere gratitude to the expert reviewers who have contributed their valuable insights to the journal's articles. Since the implementation of the online submission and review system, the journal has maintained the following key statistics:

- **Days to First Editorial Decision:** 19 days
- **Days to Acceptance:** 148 days
- **Days to Rejection:** 72 days
- **Acceptance Rate:** 61%
- **Rejection Rate:** 27%

This milestone reflects our ongoing commitment to enhancing the quality and impact of Clinical Critical Care in the global academic community.

In 2024, there were 19 publications in the Clinical Critical Care journal, categorized as follows: 1 Original Article, 5 Review Articles, 11 Research Protocols, 1 Case Report, and 1 Guideline, as shown in Table 1.
