
EDITORIAL

This is the final issue of the Thai J Obstet Gynaecol in the current Executive Board of the Royal Thai College of Obstetricians and Gynaecologists (RTCOG 2010-2012). During this period, we published editorials, special articles, case reports, review articles, obstetric and gynaecologic original articles for 12, 9, 3, 3, 45 and 14 publications, respectively.

The special articles were contributed by obstetricians and gynaecologists as well as specialists in other fields such as pediatricians, radiologists, otolaryngologists and epidemiologists.

We are successfully put Thai J Obstet Gynaecol into the Thai Journal Citation Index (TCI) as the second group journal (the journals which quality does not reach the TCI requirement and yet listed in the TCI database). The quality of Thai J Obstet Gynaecol is improving and we plan to resubmit our data before the end of 2012 in order to be approved as the first group journal in January 2013. The impact factors of the Thai J Obstet Gynaecol, accredited by TCI, increase from 0.029 in 2010 to 0.092 in 2011.

During this period, Thai J Obstet Gynaecol has awarded certificates to the best obstetrical and the best gynaecological original articles published in Thai J Obstet Gynaecol in 2010 and the best obstetrical original article published in 2011.

All the editorial process of each paper submitted to the Thai J Obstet Gynaecol will be used TCI online system only through www.tci-thaijo.org from November 1st, 2012. The prominent RTCOG bulletin (Thai language) is also republished this year (2012) as an e-journal for obstetricians and gynecologists as well as general practitioner. We hope that all dear colleagues and members enjoy our Thai J Obstet Gynaecol during the period of 2010-2012.

Finally, I would like to sincerely thank my editorial boards and reviewers for their hard work and dedication for Thai J Obstet Gynecol during 2010-2012.
