Progressive PSA Elevation

To the Editor of TMJ:

In TMJ's 2019, April-June issue, pages 109-114, I reported a series of progressively elevated PSA during the five-year follow-up period of an apparently healthy 73 year-old business tycoon. I had not previously discussed the surprising revelations at that time.

Despite that the person did not have any ill feeling, he went for another PSA test on May 30, 2019 at the Department of Pathology, Faculty of Medicine Ramathibodi Hospital (HN:5262273). The result of the test indicated a raise of PSA level to 60.170 ng/ml.

I have written this letter to seek help to explain the consecutive rising of serial PSA levels during the period of 2015-2019 in this apparently healthy person.

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
